



As you know, Boardman Schools has a long tradition of excellence in Academics, Arts and Athletics. What you might not know, is each year teachers have the opportunity to strengthen that tradition by applying for a grant to the Boardman Schools Fund for Educational Excellence (BSFEE). These grant dollars supplement the school's curriculum and enable teachers to offer students experiences that go beyond what is provided by state and local funding.

A few of the many outstanding experiences have included:

- **OSMO Genius Kits**, used by elementary students to assist with learning through problem solving, coding, puzzles, and spatial relations activities
- **Trail Cameras**, allowing fifth through eighth grade students to observe and study local park ecosystems from their own classrooms
- **Reader Pens**, interactive devices which help high school students with reading difficulties and allow for increased reading independence

Since the start of the fund in 2009, BSFEE has been able to award more than \$75,000 in grants and projects thanks to generous support from the Boardman community as well as annual donations totaling \$18,100 from the Boardman Education Association. The extraordinary circumstances of the past year also provided unique opportunities to contribute to the district. In addition to donating WiFi hotspots used for remote learning, BSFEE sponsored BHS senior t-shirts (a tradition that otherwise would have been bypassed) and helped Boardman Schools start a new tradition by sponsoring yard signs for incoming kindergarteners.


